

# NOTICE!

Since rear mats have the same shape as they did from the factory, they will need trimming on bucket seat applications. GM used this procedure from 1964-72. It is best to lay the rear floor mats in the car and mark where it needs to be trimmed with a sharp razor knife to clear the seat track. It will need to be trimmed similarly to the image below. To give a more factory appearance it is best to round the corners. Once you do one side you can flip it over and use as template on the opposite side.
